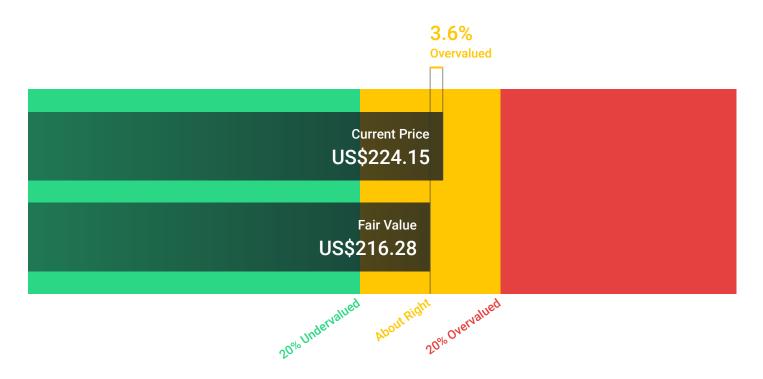

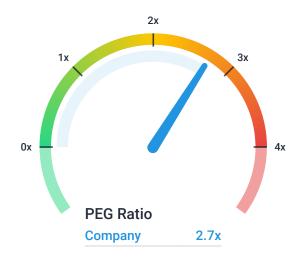

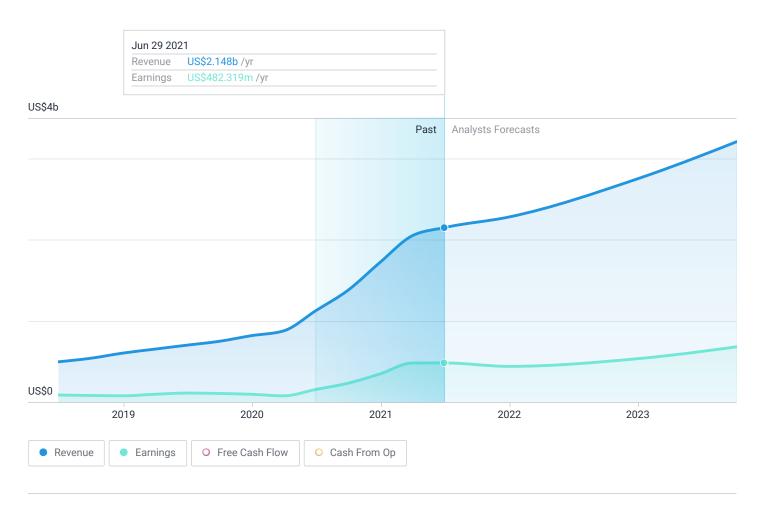

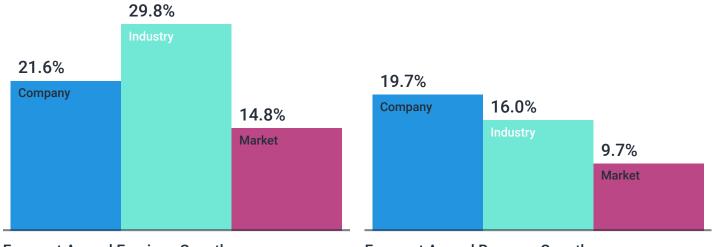

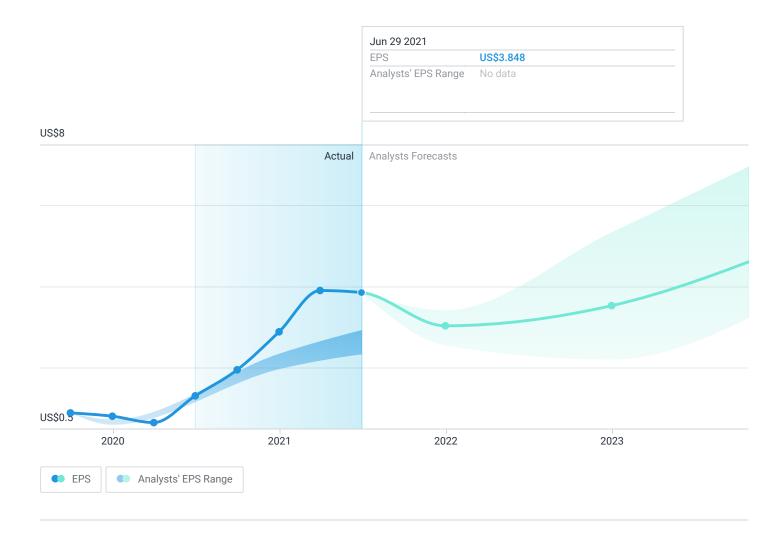

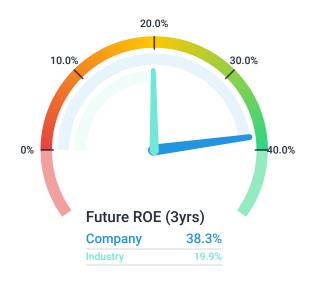
Forecast Annual Revenue Growth

- Earnings vs Savings Rate: ETSY's forecast earnings growth (21.6% per year) is above the savings rate (2%).
- Earnings vs Market: ETSY's earnings (21.6% per year) are forecast to grow faster than the US market (14.9% per year).
- High Growth Earnings: earnings are expected to grow significantly over the next 3 years.
- Revenue vs Market: ETSY's revenue (19.7% per year) is forecast to grow faster than the US market (9.7% per year).
- High Growth Revenue: ETSY's revenue (19.7% per year) is forecast to grow slower than 20% per year.

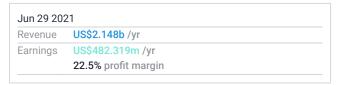


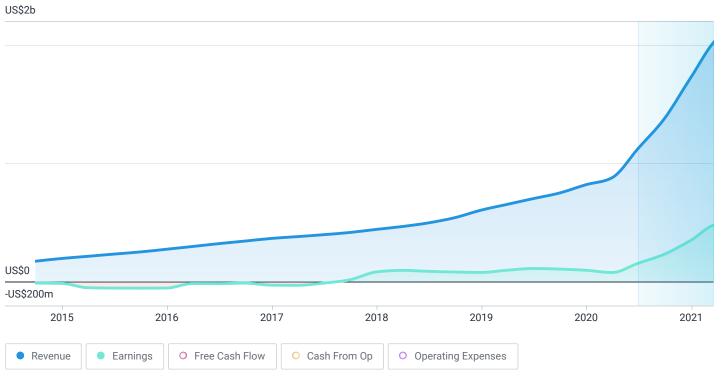

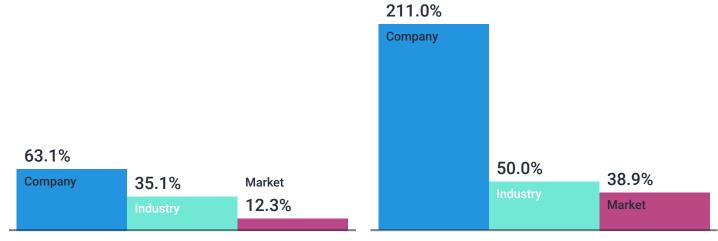
3.1 Earnings and Revenue History

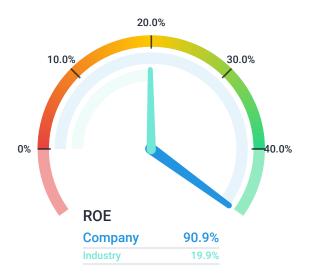


Past 5 Years Annual Earnings Growth

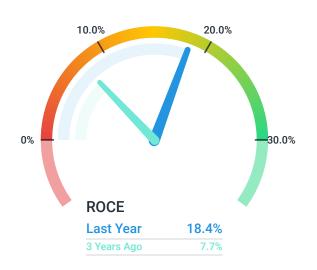


High ROE: Whilst ETSY's Return on Equity (90.87%) is outstanding, this metric is skewed due to their high level of debt.

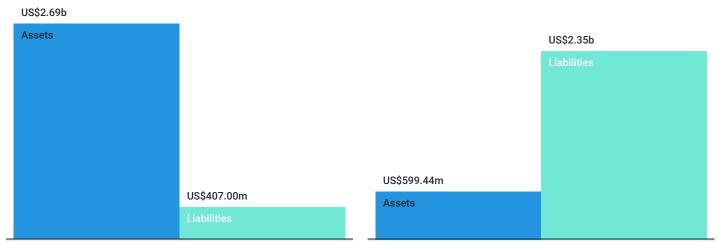

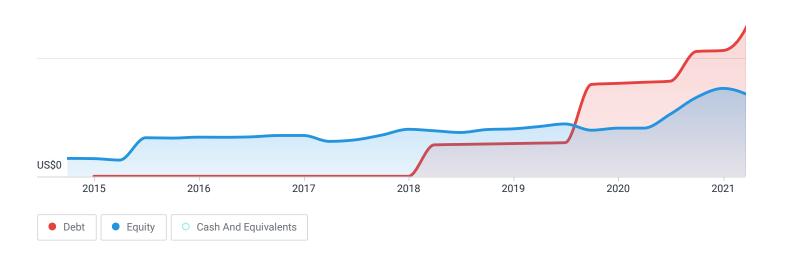
Short Term Liabilities: ETSY's short term assets (\$2.7B) exceed its short term liabilities (\$407.0M).

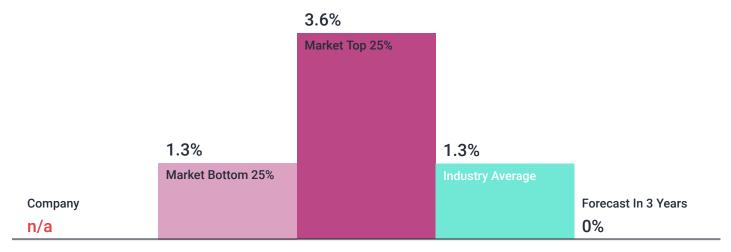

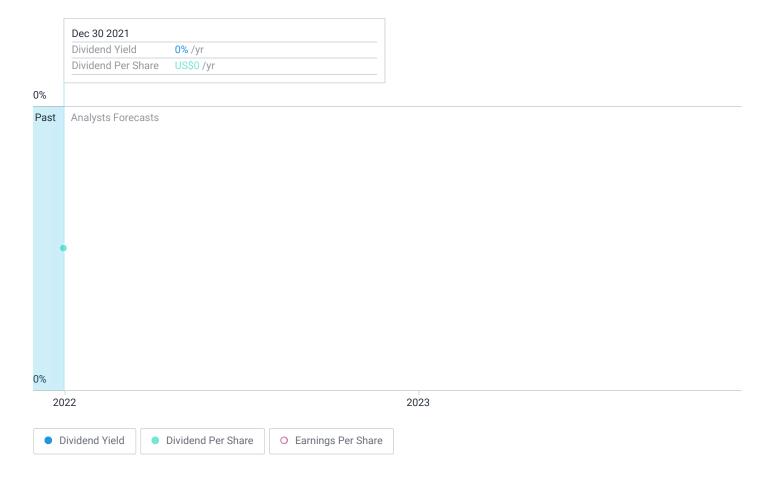
Dividend Yield vs Market

He was the Chief Executive Officer of eBay Marketplace Israel Ltd. He previously held this position from October 2010 through June 2011. Mr. Silverman served as the President of Consumer Products and Services at American Express Company from June 2011 to December 2015. He served as the Senior Operating Advisor at Hellman & Friedman, since January 2017.

Mr. Silverman joined American Express Company in 2011. He is an entrepreneurial executive who has built and run some of the world's most loved consumer Internet companies. Previously, Mr. Silverman served as the President of Skype Technologies S.A. and served as its Chief Executive Officer from March 24, 2008 to October 31, 2010. He served as the President and Chief Executive Officer of Skype Limited February 2008 until September 2010 and Skype Inc. Mr. Silverman served as the Chief Executive Officer of Skype Global S.à r.l. from March 2008 to October 2010.

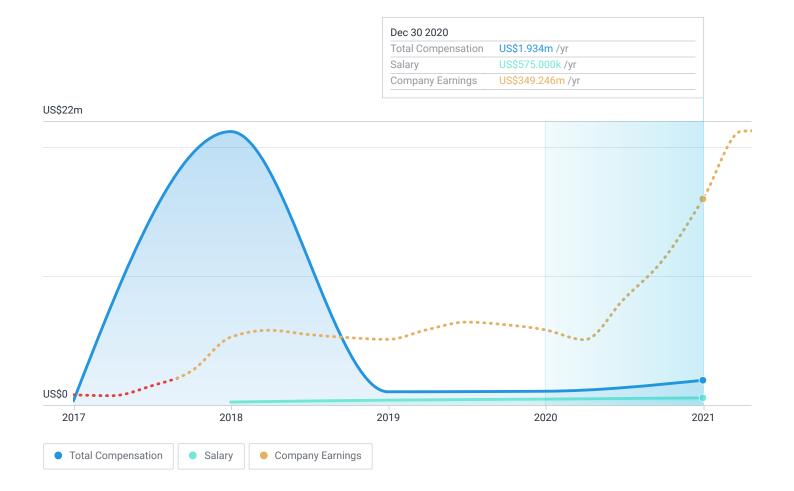
Prior to Skype, he served as a Senior Executive of eBay Inc., from 2003 to 2008. From December 2003 until June 2006, Mr. Silverman served in a variety of leadership roles at eBay, including served as its Vice President and General Manager of eBay Netherlands and Marktplaats B.V and was responsible for helping to build eBay's extremely successful classifieds businesses in Europe. He served as the Managing Director of Marktplaats.nl from December 2003 until June 2006. Mr. Silverman served as the Chief Executive Officer of eBay's Shopping.com Ltd.

from July 2006 to March 2008 and also served as its General Manager and Vice President of Products. Mr. Silverman cofounded Evite, LLC and served as its Chief Executive Officer from December 1998 until May 2001. Mr. Silverman served as the Chief Executive Officer of Shopping.com and from December 2003 until June 2006, Mr. Silverman served as Managing Director of Markplaats.nl & eBay NL, a Dutch subsidiary of eBay. He served in various management positions at ADAC Labs.

Mr. Silverman served as a Management Consultant of Booz Allen & Hamilton. He started his career on the staff of United States Senator Bill Bradley. He has been a Director of Shake Shack Inc. since November 17, 2016. He has been a Director of Etsy, Inc. since November 15, 2016, Lincoln Center Theater, Clubbed Thumb Theater and Stanford Graduate School of Business.

He also served on the Consumer Advisory Board of the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau from 2012 to 2015. Mr. Silverman holds an M.B.A. from Stanford Graduate School of Business in 1997, where he was an Arjay Miller Scholar and a B.A. in Public Policy from Brown University in 1991. Mr. Silverman currently serves on the board of directors of not-for-profit organization Code Nation which equips students in under-resourced schools with both fundamental coding skills and professional experiences.

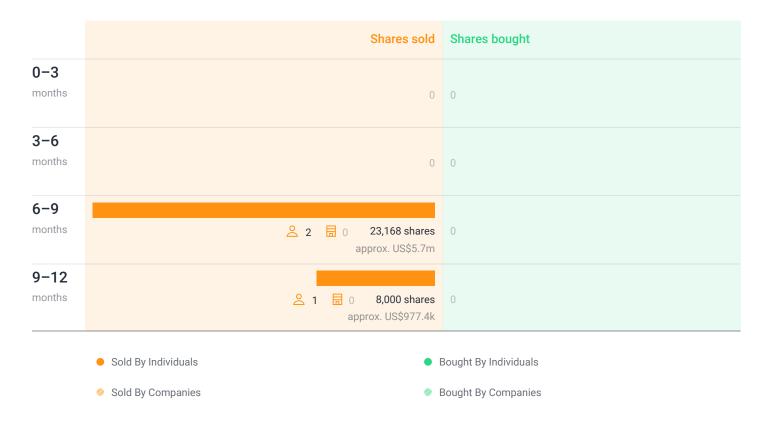

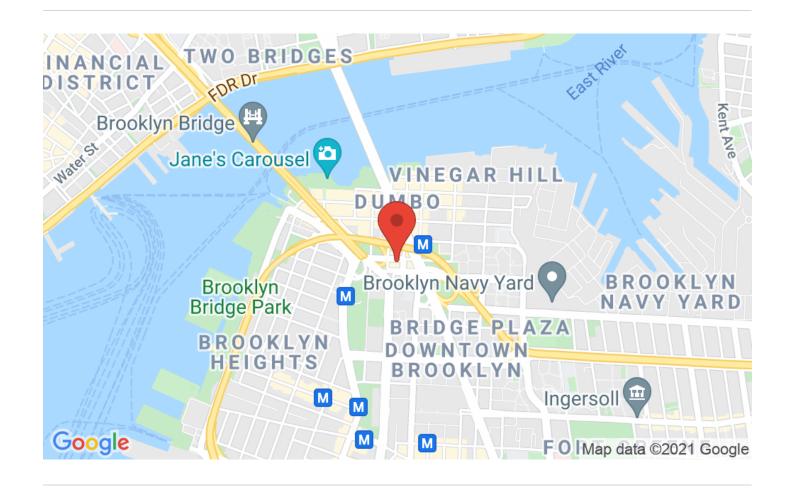
